Tutoring service expands to Maryland

Educational Connections Inc., an in-home tutoring service for K-12 students in the Northern Virginia and Washington area, expanded its services to Montgomery County.

The Fairfax-based, 10-year-old company opened the office in Bethesda, its second location. The office provides educational consultations, academic assessments, and workshops for parents and tutors.

"In the past year, we have noticed an increase in the number of prospective clients residing in Montgomery County and felt that having a second office closer to their homes would allow us to better serve their needs," said Ann Dolin, president and founder, who is a former teacher in the Fairfax County school system.

The company contracts with more than 100 tutors holding bachelor's degrees in the Northern Virginia area and services about 300 students.

Dolin hopes to meet those benchmarks in Montgomery County within the next two years.
